- **STEP ONE: APPLY ONLINE FOR ADMISSION**

- **STEP TWO: ASSESSMENT**

Most likely, your scores from SAT/ACT/TAKS/TAAS will exempt you from further testing, but you will need to obtain an official transcript from UT (MAI, Room 1) to verify your scores.

- **STEP THREE: ADVISING**

If you are applying to ACC for the first time, you will need to complete an online module and then meet with an Academic Advisor.

- **STEP FOUR: REGISTRATION**

You will need to check the registration calendars for ACC on their website, as enrollment times are different from those at UT.

If you are planning to take classes at ACC while you are taking classes at UT, you will need to apply for permission to be concurrently enrolled. You may apply online through the College of Engineering website at:
