- **STEP ONE: DETERMINE YOUR CREDIT OPTIONS**

Use the charts at the site above or refer to the chart below.

- **STEP TWO: MEET WITH YOUR ADVISOR**

For many reasons, it is suggested you meet with your academic advisor prior to claiming credit from your scores— the College has very limited hours which may be completed by exam.

- **STEP THREE: CLAIM CREDITS ONLINE**

After meeting with your advisor, return to the site above and follow the steps to claim your credit.

- **STEP FOUR: PAY FOR YOUR CLAIMED CREDITS**

Your credit will not be officially posted, or you will be barred from future registration, until you pay your fees for your claims.

For exams *received at UT* on or after September 16, 2006 (if a student receives an eligible score for credit), the student may only claim 'CR' to be used toward their degree— there is no longer an option to claim a grade toward your UT GPA.

CR from placement exams will still be used to fulfill degree requirements despite the requirement of 'C' or better in all degree requirements.
